CanSkate

CanSkate is a dynamic learn-to-skate program that focuses on fun, participation and basic skill development that is designed to teach the basic skills of skating; forwards, backwards, stopping, turning, and jumping, creating a foundation for more advanced skating skills. Participants earn incentives of ribbons and badges to mark their progress through stages of Balance, Agility & Control Stages 1 to 6 in this program.

A one hour program consisting of a 45-minute lesson taught in a group format using teaching aids, upbeat music in a motivational environment to promote learning and 15-minutes of free-time or optional private lesson time. This program is aimed for participants ages 5+.

The Bridge Program

This program is for skaters that have completed CanSkate Stage 4 and are working on completing CanSkate Stage 5 or 6. As well is an introduction to the StarSkate (Skills, Tests, Achievement, and Recognition) stream of figure skating. This is a fast track program for skaters who have been identified as having an aptitude for figure skating which offers a 30-minute structured group lesson taught by a Skate Canada certified coach, 30-minutes of practice time and/or a private lesson time, and includes a 15-minute fitness class specific to the Bridge program athletes. Entrance to the program is strictly by letter of invitation, audition, or at the discretion of the Director of CanSkate. It is encouraged that skaters in the Bridge program start private lessons with one of our certified Skate Canada coaches to enhance their skill progression.
